The Online Guild is affiliated to the Association of Guilds of Weavers, Spinners and Dyers, but is completely autonomous within this framework.

'Meetings' take place over the internet via an email list set up in Groups.io. This list is not listed in the Group.io directory and membership is restricted. Upon payment of the appropriate fee you will be subscribed to the list. This list is the principal vehicle for the conveyance of news, chat, tips, advice, help, workshop notes, etc. The facilities of Groups.io to upload pictures and files to the list are used to help members share in the display of their work to others and also to pass on technical instructions, etc.

Members are expected to have email and web access.

The Guild's membership year runs from 1 January to 31 December, however for new members joining part way through the year fees are adjusted. Fees include the appropriate numbers of The Journal (the magazine of the Association), affiliation fees to the Association plus a small amount for overheads:
